

Downloading Videos to iPads with TechSmith Capture

First you will need to download the App - TechSmith Capture App

Then you will need to make sure you have the screen recording button enabled on your iPad. Go to settings > Control Center > Tap the Green + sign for Screen Recording. If it has a red - sign, it is already enabled.

You will want to check that restrictions are off for your iPad. Go to settings > General > Restrictions > Screen Recordings - it is on the bottom under Game Center and enable it if it isn't already.

Find clip you want to record. You can record from YouTube, Facebook, etc. Open it and set it up so it is ready to play. Hit the home button.

Open the Capture App; Click the + button on the top left of the screen. Swipe up on the right side to reveal your dock; (I could only do it when the iPad was horizontal)

Hit the Record icon on the bottom right of your "dock". It is the circle within a circle.

A 3-2-1 countdown will start giving you time to hit the home button then open your media - it should be ready to go. Once it opens up you are recording.

Stop video when you are ready. Close it; you will still be recording. On the top you should see a red bar & hit it and menu will pop up. With 'Stop Video' as an option. That video will be saved in your photos.

Go to photos. Open your video and choose edit. You can choose when the clip begins and ends by adjusting the bar on the bottom of the screen.
