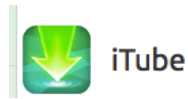
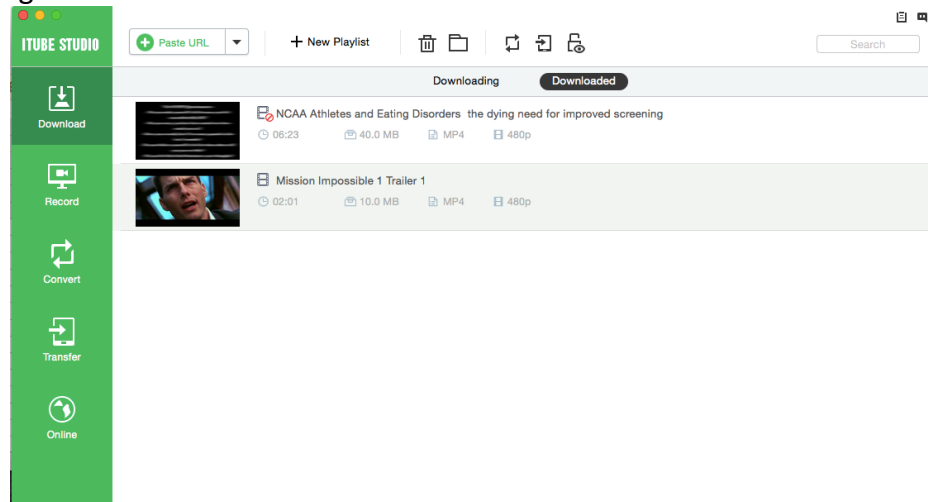


## Downloading Video Using iTube Studio

1. Download application from at <https://itube.aimersoft.com>  
Free trial, subscription (\$24.99/year); purchase (\$34.99)Af




2. After download, open iTube Studio (in your applications). When open, it will look something like this:



3. Open YouTube and find the video you want to capture.
4. Highlight the url for the YouTube page.
5. Copy the url using Control c

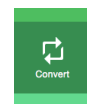
6. In ITube Studio, click on the “paste url” button in top ribbon



7. Video will begin downloading in “Downloading” cube—click on that tab if not visible.
8. After download is complete, the file will be in “Downloaded”cube-click on that tab.
9. Click on “convert”  icon in the box for your video (not the convert icon in the green banner)

10. Select convert size preference (I typically select the largest available).

11. Conversion will start. When complete, click on convert icon in green banner. You will see a list of videos converted. You’re done!



12. Right click on video title and click on “Show in Finder” and it will appear for your use.

### Another way to Download

1. Install the download icon for your browser.
2. It will appear on your YouTube video.
3. Click Download.
4. Follow same process above.
