What are the requirements to become a judge?

Take the test

Level 4/5 test and one
Optional test

What are the requirements to become a judge?

Level 4/5 Rating

Eligible for all compulsory levels & some beginning XCEL levels

Level 8 Rating

Eligible for XCEL and 6/7/8

What are the requirements to become a judge?

Level 9 Rating

Eligible for Level 6-9 and XCEL

Level 10 Rating

Eligible for 6 – 10 and XCEL and Collegiate Gymnastics

Special Exception for College Gymnasts

- A candidate may begin testing at Level 9 if they were a ...Regional/National competitor as a Senior Level 10 or a college gymnast who competed at Regional/Nationals (any division) as a Collegiate gymnast.
- Those qualified individuals may begin testing at Levels 4/5 and/or Level 9.

Exception for Former Senior Elite Athletes

• A candidate may begin testing at Level 10 if they were a former ... Senior Elite gymnast who participated at a National Elite Classic or above competition.

Those qualified individuals may begin testing at Levels 4/5 and/or 10.

Exemption Eligibility Form





JUDGING ACCREDITATION EXEMPTION ELIGIBILITY FORM

A candidate may begin testing at Level 9 if they are a former or current Level 10 or Collegiate coach who coached at a Regional/National Championships, or a Regional/National competitor as a Senior Level 10 or Collegiate gymnast. Those qualified individuals may begin testing at Levels 4/5 and/or Level 9.

A candidate may begin testing at Level 10 if they are a former or present Elite Coach or Senior Elite gymnast who participated at a National Elite Classic or above competition. Those qualified individuals may begin testing at Levels 4/5 and/or 10.





Online Level 4/5 Compulsory Judging Exam Registration

- Registration is available for the **Online Level 4/5 Compulsory Judging exam**. Registration for the Level 4/5 Judging exam is available to both members and non-members of USA Gymnastics who are a minimum of 14 years of age. You must have a username/password. Haven't created a username and password? <u>Click here</u>
- Once registered, you may take the exam at your convenience. Be aware that on 50-question multiple choice exam, you will have 60 minutes to complete it. Results will be sent of CSA Gymnastics within several days of completion of the exam. Click here to register.



OPTIONAL LEVEL 7/8, 9, 10 EXAM REGISTRATIONS:

WRITTEN (theoretical) EXAMS: Beginning August 1, 2022, the new 2022-26 Development Program Optional Written exams (50-question multiple choice) will be available as online exams ONLY. Cost: \$25.

Important Notice: If you are registering for the Level 9 or 10 Written exam for the first time, please be aware that you must have held the Level 7/8 or Level 9 rating respectively for a minimum of one year before being eligible to "test up". There will not be a 30-day "grace period" for registration of the Written exam.

- Join USA Gymnastics as Professional Member
 - Complete a Background Check
 - Complete the Safety & Risk Management Course
 - Complete Safe Sport Training
 - Complete review of USAG Safe Sport Policy
- O Join other organizations if offered in your locale, e.g. AAU, USAIGC, NGA

What else do I need to do?

- Join NAWGJ at NAWGJ.org
- Practice judge at the levels you will be judging
- Complete CPE (Continuing Professional Education) credits each year to be eligible to accept contracts (after first year).

How do I get assigned to meets?

- Most states use online assigning system
- Register in the system
- Enter dates you are available
- Accept assignments following email notification; generate a contract




