Professional Expectations for Collegiate Judges and Consequences

All collegiate judges are expected to follow the NAWGJ Code of Professional Responsibility posted on the NAWGJ website. In addition, judges are expected to follow the Social Media guidelines.

The collegiate program has stated consequences associated with unprofessional or unethical behavior. Specifically:

Participation in unprofessional or unethical behavior involving collegiate gymnastics may result in the loss of assignment to conference championships or post-season events and/or reduction in future assignments. Examples include but are not limited to:

- non-compliance with NAWGJ canons and rules, social media guidelines, or professional dress guidelines;
- falsification of information;
- declining a meet after accepting the assignment in RTN/JAS for reasons considered to be unprofessional;
- failure to complete requirements for eligibility (required test, required clinics if applicable)
- other professional behavior.
