NCAA Meet Referee Duties: Review with Meet Director & Judges

- 1. Viewing Warm-ups: prior to the competition:
 - Judges may **NOT** view the pre-meet warm-ups.
- 2. <u>Judges Meeting:</u> **45 minutes** prior to competition, Review Checklist and procedures.
 - Take deductions that you can verify and be consistent.
- 3. Hand Scoring Sheet & Order of Competition for each judge, prior to the competition.
 - Score slips delivered to the event, sign, and double check the order.
- 4. Paper Trail for the competition (J2 to J1), notate deficiencies, OB, etc., need runners.
 - 4 runners needed (one per event).
- 5. Timers: UB (Falls), BB (Falls & Routine), FX (Routine) give instructions prior to the meet.
 - 4 stop watches are needed for a quad meet.
- 6. <u>Line Judges:</u> (2-FX) on opposite corners of the judges, give instructions prior to the meet.
 - Yellow flags for each Line judge.
 - Paper and pen to record out of bounds for CJ (-0.1 OB).
- 7. FX Music: coaches responsible for checking the "timing" of routines.
 - Timer for FX may also be a **Line Judge**.
- 8. SV / Score / UTL Flashers: simultaneously display both the SV, Score, UTL, VT # Flasher.
 - Give instructions to helpers, CJ helper is the "captain" of the event.
- 9. Conferences: Out of Range, Impossible SV, UTL or Inquiry.
 - Pro Score display scores before the conference, then change scores, if needed.
- 10. Written Inquiry & Video Inquiry: taken directly to CJ after the rotation has been completed.
 - Completed before the next rotation begins,
 - Changes subject to additional deductions.
- 11. Neutral Deductions: may be corrected if a mistake is made and deduction not taken.
 - **Display** neutral deductions (signs for OB or OT).
- 12. Out of Order: (- 0.1 **TEAM**) submit deduction to the meet director.
 - May change order <u>before</u> 1st athlete's signal,
 - After 1st athlete must replace in same order.
 - After an athlete signals CJ may <u>not</u> substitute for another athlete.
- 13. Mounting Distances:
 - UB / BB Mounts = $27^{\circ}6^{\circ}$ length of manufactured mats.
- 14. Plywood Board for Beam and Bars
 - Non-skid surface on both sides of the board, must move plywood / board.
- 15. **Equipment Penalties (6.2):**
 - - 0.2 CJ TEAM <u>improper use of equipment</u> per manufacturing specifications.
 - - 0.2 CJ TEAM ONE time <u>foreign substance</u> (Tuff Skin, honey & water, etc.).
 - -0.2 CJ TEAM each time $-\underline{\text{VT funnel lines}}$ clearly mark the lines (with tape).
 - - 0.2 CJ TEAM each time <u>FX boundary lines</u> clearly mark the mats (with tape).
 - - 0.2 CJ TEAM each time <u>FX more than one mat per pass</u> (sting or 4-inch mat).

Equipment Penalties (6.2): (continued)

- - 0.2 CJ TEAM (each occurrence)
 - 1. Incorrect use of tape/chalk on equipment
 - a. Using chalk on VT runway (tape/Velcro allowed)
 - b. Use of tape on BB
 - c. Using tape or Velcro within boundary lines (except to mark corners).
 - d. Tape on the <u>hand placement mat</u> (RO pad).
 - 2. Use of <u>unauthorized supplement mats</u> = 10" max. (VT, UB, BB)
 - 3. Use of <u>hand placement mat for VT</u> (for traditional forward approach vaults)
 - 4. Use of springboard on unauthorized surface (8-inch skill cushion)
 - 5. Failure to remove the board/mounting apparatus after a mount.
 - 6. Failure to remove an authorized spotting device after use.
 - 7. Using <u>incorrect apparatus specification</u> (including springboard configuration, safety collar VT).
- 16. Unsportsmanlike Conduct: "Did behavior distract you from judging."
 - Yellow Card warning for first offense; given by panel judge, CJ, or MR.
 - - 0.1 TEAM each time after a Yellow Card warning (Coach, Staff, Athlete).
- 17. <u>Uniform Deductions & Warnings</u>: inform the MR if a warning has been issued.
 - Jewelry (- 0.2 CJ) after warning, each event; must remove jewelry, OK stud piercings.
 - Out of Uniform (- <u>0.3 **TEAM**</u>) after warning, comp #, non-identical team leotard.
- 18. Warm-up Time Exceeded: (- 0.2 off TEAM) after warning; OK if preparing to perform skill.
- 19. Video Review Process:
 - Meet Dir. facilitator (no coaches); 5 min. after the meet (note End Time).
 - On the Field of Play, by the Event Panel + MR or next highest rated judge (majority rules).
 - Video Camera / TV, Slow Motion OK, Specific to Value Part or Neutral Deductions.
 - NO Team deduction,
 - Score change subject to additional deductions (example: rhythm).
 - 0.1 Team deduction (automatic) for request to evaluate execution deductions.
- 20. <u>Check Scores</u> off the floor in judge's room, check individual scores and sign score sheets.
 - Summary Review forms completed after the score sheets are checked and signed.
 - Officially release the Judges after the Head Coaches have signed the score sheet.
