

## How to Access Video Clips for On-Site Review 2025

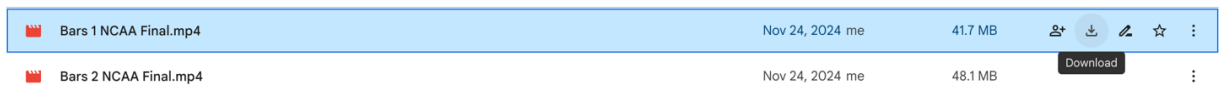
Judging panels are expected to conduct on-site reviews prior to each competition. Please select videos from schools that are NOT competing in the meet you are judging. All review routines are available on the NAWGJ website and may be viewed online. However, if you are judging in an arena with a weak internet connection, you may have trouble accessing the videos on our website. Therefore, you can download short, individual routines or a longer video that has all 20 routines for each event prior to the meet so you can watch them **off-line**. Download instructions are below (two methods).

**1. How To Download Directly To Your Device.** Use this link to access the Google File:

**2.** Download the individual clips you want and save them to your own device. To download:

- Click on the name of a video to download
- Click on the “download” icon on the right (see example below)



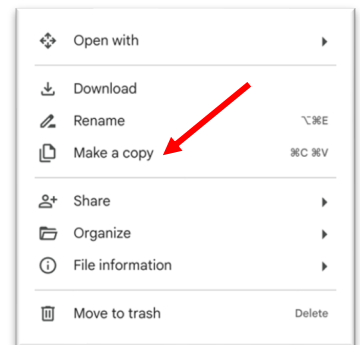
- If you get a message that says the file is too large for google to scan for security, ignore the warning and click ok (we are a trusted source).
- The video will download to your device (find it in your downloads folder).
- Save (or transfer) the file to the device you will take with you to the meet (Ipad, phone, laptop).

**3. How To Copy Videos to Your Own Google Drive (if you have one).**

**When copying from our google file, please do not use the drag and drop function to transfer them to your own drive.** If you drag the original, it will no longer be available for other users. If you want a copy on your own google drive, select “**Make a Copy**” from the pull-down menu (right click on the name of the video you want) and then drag the **COPY** of the video to your own drive.



**Make videos in your Google Drive available offline.** This is the most reliable method to use if you are in a weak internet environment. Clips that are off-line do not require internet access to view and you should have no trouble playing them during the judge’s meeting. Search the internet for short tutorials on how to make google files available offline. Instructions are not provided here because it varies depending on your current settings and device.

**Caution:** After you select “Make available offline,” wait until the entire video has downloaded to your device before closing the Google app. If you don’t wait, the video won’t be viewable when you try to open it later.
