

# Collegiate Gymnastics Technical Performance Inquiry Procedure

## Purpose:

This procedure allows WCGA coaches to submit inquiries regarding specific technical performance concerns related to their own team's routine performances. It is intended for legitimate questions and not for routine challenges, general judging complaints, or disputes about other teams' scores.

Technical performance concerns are those solely related to the value given a particular skill, vault or skill connection, whether a particular skill met or did not meet the technical requirements for that skill, and whether certain skills were connected or disconnected.

The USA Gymnastics National Technical Committee (“Tech Committee”) reserves the right to review or decline any submission at their sole discretion. Submission does not guarantee a review or response.

## Submission Guidelines:

### 1. Eligibility

- Only head coaches or designated staff may submit an inquiry.
- Inquiries must pertain **only** to the coach's own team.
- Must be during regular season.

### 2. Format & Requirements

- Submissions must be made via the following form:  
<https://forms.cloud.microsoft/r/PVvK3wAAQe> and must include an unedited video of the skill, skills, vault or connection in question.
- The National Coordinator of Officials (“NCO”) will provide the submission to the Tech Committee.
- Required information on the form:
  - Meet details (date, location, teams).
  - Gymnast's name and event.
  - A **clear, specific** description of the concern (e.g., “Was the leap series connected?”).
  - A description of how the concern was handled at the meet in question, if known.
  - Provision of video footage of the concern.

### 3. Limited to 3 Submissions for the Season

## Review Process:

- The **Tech Committee** will determine if a review is warranted.
  - If reviewed, responses will be provided through the NCO, and may include:
    - Confirmation of the values given.
    - Confirmation of the connection or non-connection.
    - Clarification on a technical performance.
    - A ruling that a misjudgment occurred (without altering results).
  - The videos and any decisions **cannot** be used in any future competitions.
  - **Decisions are final; no appeals process exists.**

## Reminders:

- ✓ Intended for **legitimate technical performance questions.**
- ✓ **Professional communication** is expected.
- ✗ **Excessive or frivolous submissions may result in restrictions.**
- ✗ **Complaints about another team's scores will not be accepted.**
