

## 2026 Season – How to Access the On-Site Review Videos

Judging panels are required to conduct reviews of a minimum of two routines on-site prior to the start of each competition. All On-Site Review Routines may be viewed online.


However, if you are judging in an arena with a weak internet connection, you may have trouble accessing the videos on the Google drive. Therefore, you can download short, individual routines or a longer video that has all of the routines for each event prior to the meet so you can watch them off-line. Download instructions are below (two methods).

1. **How To Access the On-Site Review Videos:** Use this link to access the Google Folders (there is a separate folder for each event):

2. **How To Download Directly To Your Device:** Download the individual clips you want and save them to your own device. To download:


- Click on the name of a video to download
- Click on the “download” icon on the right (see example below)



- If you get a message that says the file is too large for google to scan for security, ignore the warning and click ok (we are a trusted source).
- The video will download to your device (find it in your downloads folder).
- Save (or transfer) the file to the device you will take with you to the meet (Ipad, phone, laptop).

3. **How To Copy Videos to Your Own Google Drive (if you have one):**

- Go to the same link in #1, above.
- **When copying from our Google folders, please do not use the drag and drop function to transfer them to your own drive.** If you drag the original, it will no longer be available for other users.
- To make a copy on your own google drive, select the 3 dots next to the file and that will bring up the menu.
- The select “Make a Copy” which will create a version of the file with “Copy of” in the file name.
- Then, drag the COPY you just made to your own drive.



4. **How to make videos in your Google Drive available offline:** This is the most reliable method to use if you are in a weak internet environment. Clips that are off-line do not require internet access to view and you should have no trouble playing them during the judges’ meeting. Search the internet for short tutorials on how to make google files available offline. Instructions are not provided here because it varies depending on your current settings and device.

- **Caution:** After you select “Make available offline,” wait until the entire video has downloaded to your device before closing the Google app. If you don’t wait, the video won’t be viewable when you try to open it later.
